The Perfit<sup>®</sup> Bumper is a perfect adjunct to all our Ortho-Tain<sup>®</sup> appliances which are used for deciduous, mixed and adult dentitions that have 4 to 6mm of crowding. It is ideal for the adult, since the labial shield is hidden by the upper or lower lip, making it barely detectable.

- Distalizes deciduous or permanent molars (upper or lower) 1mm per month
- Takes only 1 to 3 try-ins for a perfect fit – saves 15 minutes in fitting
- Comes in 8 convenient sizes and made of .045 wire
- Protects anchorage

## **Measuring Instructions**

### FOR THE 5 - 7 YEAR OLD

### FOR USE WITH THESE APPLIANCES:

- Nite-Guide<sup>®</sup> "C" Series
- Nite-Guide<sup>®</sup> "G" Series (Occlus-o-Guide<sup>®</sup>)

The size of the appliance is stamped on upper left hand margin. Each appliance on the upper arch is 1.5mm apart and on the lower arch is 0.8mm apart.





Place pointer at mesial of lower left canine

To mesial of lower right canine

Place pointer of pink ruler at mesial of lower or upper left deciduous canine; bend ruler along incisal edges (or along ideal arch form) and read size at mesial of right deciduous canine. Add two sizes to measurement for potentially crowded cases (example:  $2 \rightarrow 2-1/2 \rightarrow 3$ ). This larger sized appliance is used in anticipation of expansion of the arches to provide space for the predicted adult crowding. The second appliance ("G" Series) is usually 3 sizes larger than the first ("C" Series) appliance used after the lower laterals begin erupting.

OR

#### **"C" SERIES – FIRST APPLIANCE**

First appliance ("C" Series) inserted when lower centrals begin erupting. Select "C" Series appliance two sizes larger than measurement (example:  $2 \rightarrow 2-1/2 \rightarrow 3$ ).

#### "G" SERIES – SECOND APPLIANCE

Second appliance ("G" Series) inserted when lower laterals start to erupt. Select "G" Series appliance three sizes larger (example:  $3C \Rightarrow 3-1/2 \Rightarrow 4 \Rightarrow 4-1/2G$ ).

Note: If the 6 year old molars are present when treatment is initiated, substitute a "G" Series appliance instead of a "C" Series appliance to prevent molars from super-erupting. The second appliance used when adult lower laterals start to erupt should be a "G" Series appliance that is 3 sizes larger than the first "G" Series appliance used. Both "G" Series appliances are worn only while sleeping.

Place the pointer of the pink ruler at the distal of the upper or lower left lateral and bend the ruler along the incisal edges to the distal of the right lateral. Be sure to use the correct side of the ruler marked either "lower incisors" or "upper incisors."

OR

Each size on the pink ruler is 1.5mm apart on the upper and 0.8mm on the lower. If there is no crowding or spacing the size measured on the ruler is used. If a patient has 1.5mm of upper anterior crowding and the size measured is a 4G, a 4-1/2G would be used to provide space for correction. If there is 3mm of upper anterior spacing and a 4G is measured on the ruler, a 3G would have to be used to close the spaces. In such a case, the appliance would be stretched across the spaced anterior teeth.

An alternate method is to measure the mesio-distal widths of the four upper or lower incisors in millimeters and select the Occlus-o-Guide® appliance that corresponds to this total measurement from the chart.

Place the pointer of the white ruler at the distal of the upper left canine then bend it along the incisal edges to the distal of the upper right canine. For retention after orthodontic bracket removal select an appliance that is one size smaller than the size indicated on the ruler for an optimal result.

Note: One side of the ruler measures non-extraction and two upper premolar extractions. The other side measures four premolar extractions.
